Essential Staffing – Questions to Consider

1. What are the critical duties you will need preformed in an emergency?
2. Which position does that work during regular duties?
3. Is the employee in that position able to perform those duties in an emergency?
 - ✓ Would they either be able to get to the necessary location to do the work or are they equipped to do the work from home?
 - ✓ Is there any circumstance or reason they could not perform the duties?
4. Who else knows how to do the work and are they able to fill a backup role? Same questions in #3 above.




